

REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLYING FOR A NATIONAL VISA (“D”)

STUDY

1. **Visa application form**, to be completed online (<https://e-applicationvisa.esteri.it/homepage>) in all its parts, in block capitals;
2. **Passport valid for more than 6 months**, with at least two blank pages, plus a color copy of the passport and identity card (for foreigners, a copy of the residence permit or visa valid for more than three months is also required);
3. A recent, full-face color photograph against a white background, compliant with [ICAO](#) standards;
4. **Airline ticket reservation**, indicating the outbound dates (original or copy);
5. **Travel insurance with a minimum coverage of €30,000**, valid for Schengen countries (original or copy);
6. **Hotel reservation or invitation**, in this case, attaching a copy of the invitee's identity document:([link](#));
7. **Proof of socio-professional status and means of subsistence:**
 - If the applicant is a trader or business owner:
 - Official Gazette of the Republic with the legalization of the company's identity, plus personal and company bank statements for the last three months;
 - If the applicant is an employee:
 - Statement of employment (original, specifying the date of employment) accompanied by an identity document of the person signing;
 - Bank statements for the last three months, plus pay slips for the last three months;
 - If the applicant is a minor:
 - Birth certificate, legalized and translated;
 - Parental responsibility certificate for covering expenses;
 - Proof of socio-financial status and means of subsistence of parents/guarantors;
 - Travel authorization for minors, signed by the parent(s) or guardian(s), legalized and translated.
8. **Enrollment or pre-enrollment for the course** to be taken in Italy
9. For students enrolled in a university course, a printed university pre-enrollment form downloaded from the University portal
10. Declaration of value of the qualification or CIMEA certificate
11. If the request is for an **Italian language course**, documentation must demonstrate that the courses, as indicated in Article 44bis, paragraph 2, letter a, of Presidential Decree 394/1999, are of a higher level (i.e., minimum B2), full-time, and of a fixed duration.

NOTE: Payment will be made directly at the Embassy in Kwanza with TPA (with an Angolan card) or in cash, for a value of 50 euros. The request must be submitted at least fifteen days in advance of the trip; additional documents may be requested. Submitting all the necessary documentation does not imply the granting of a visa; the Embassy has sole discretion to grant or deny a visa.
